### **Living Room**

- Clean windows and screens. Leave windows open to air out room.
- Scrub the sills, baseboards and walls of dust and grime.
- Dust lights and ceiling fans.
- Vacuum/dust/launder curtains, throw pillows and throw blankets.
- Vacuum furniture, (make sure to get under the cushions).
- o Clean vents.
- o Declutter, clean and dust shelves.
- o Dust electronics.


#### **Bedrooms**

  - Store shoes/boots in containers and place in storage location.

#### **Laundry Room**

- If there are windows, clean windows and screens. Leave windows open to air out room.
- Scrub the sills, baseboards, and walls of dust and grime.
- o Dust lights and ceiling fans.
- o Clean out lint trap.
- o Wipe down dryer vent coil.
- Wipe down dyer and washer machine.
- Clean inside of washer machine.
- o Scrub the floor.

#### **Bathrooms**

- Clean windows and screens.
   Leave windows open to air out room.
- Scrub the sills, baseboards, and walls of dust and grime.
- o Dust lights and ceiling fans.
- o Empty all drawers and cabinets.
  - Clean inside and out
  - Toss expired or will not use medicine.
     (Make sure to dispose of properly)
  - ➤ Toss expired or will not use makeup.
- o Clean mirrors.
- o Scrub bathtub inside and out.
- o Scrub toilet inside and out.
- o Scrub the floors.

#### Outside

- o Clean or replace entry mats.
- o Clean outside furniture.
- Clean outside grill.
- Clean grill lines from propane tank to the grill.
- o Sweep front and back entrances and walk ways.
- Power wash decks and patios.
- o Clean and organize garage/sheds.

### **Playrooms**

- Clean windows and screens. Leave windows open to air out room.
